Millis School Committee and Select Board vote to approve the submittal of a Statement of Interest (SOI) to the Massachusetts School Building Authority (MSBA)

June 2021


SOI submitted to MSBA citing:

- Existing overcrowding
- Expected Increase in Enrollment
- Replacement, renovation, or modernization of facility systems such as roofs, windows, boilers, HVAC, . . .
- Replacement of or addition to obsolete buildings in order to provide for a full range of programs

## Eligibility Period

March 2, 2022 MSBA votes to invite Millis into the Eligibility Period

- 270 day period provides a definitive schedule for preliminary requirements
- MSBA assists with the determination of financial and community readiness
- MSBA assists with identifying needs for planning and budgeting
- 58 applicants across the state submitted SOIs
- 17 projects invited to participate in the eligibility period
- These 17 projects described as "the most needy and urgent"
